

# POLICEMAN THROWN UNDER A CAR, DIES

William Zapf, 28, of 1023 Western avenue, a motorcycle policeman, died at 6 Tuesday morning in St. Vincent's hospital from injuries received at 3 o'clock when his motorcycle skidded under an "owl" car at Superior street and Madison avenue.

Zapf and Roll M. Ramus, another motorcycle policeman, were riding on Superior street when Zapf became wedged in between an automobile and the car. In attempting to extricate himself the front wheel of his machine slipped, throwing him under the car.

His right leg and part of his left foot were severed.

## George Zapf's Machine Skids Under Trucks

Motorcycle Policeman George F. Zapf died in St. Vincent's Hospital at 10 a. m. on Tuesday, the result of a collision with a street car at Madison-av and Superior-st at 3 a. m. Tuesday.

It is said to have been riding on Madison-av, toward Superior-st, at about 15 miles an hour. An Iron-horse car, going south, is said to have failed to make the safety stop and continued toward the street intersection.

Zapf, attempting to avoid the car, was thrown against the rear end of the car. He would have been uninjured had not his coat caught on a part of the rear truck of the car. He was dragged under the car, his left foot cut off, and his right leg was broken in two places. His young wife was at his bedside when he died.

## POLICE INSPECTOR LOSES BADGE

A valuable diamond-studded police badge, presented to Inspector of Police Leutz five years ago by members of the department and fellow lodge members, is lost. Inspector Leutz noticed his loss on Tuesday afternoon, following a trip from Central Police Station to the City Hall and then to the home of Patrolman Zapf, 1023 Western-av, who was killed in an accident early Tuesday morning.
