A TRAINING school for Toledo police is ready to open. Safety Director Fall announces that the plan. often suggested, is to be put into effect. Efficiency and courtesy are the objectives. Proper preparation of reports, the collection of evidence and presentation of cases in court are among the

topics for study.
Other large cities have proved the worth of police training classes. The policeman's duties are varied and often omplicated. It is foolish to put an imtrained man into a uniform and send him out to enforce the issue without some elementary instruction in regard to fundamentals.

Clashes between officers and the po-lice court have occurred here. The judges have crilicized the police at times for not understanding what may be considered as ovidence. Schooling should help the police so they will not appear in court as embarrassed victims of legal technicalities.

The primary concern of any police

training school must be efficiency in law enforcement. There can be no substitute for that. But the highest type of police officer has efficiency plus courtesy. Every officer should be so carefully schooled that he will never forget to be well mannered in the difficult and often harassing job of serving the public.

Safety Director Fall and the police division are to be congratulated upon the new school. It deserves the full cooperation necessary to make it a suc-

One of the finest contributions to police training we know is Inspector Delehaunty's new "Guide for Police Officers." The heads of the police department should see that it gets wide circulation.

There are contained in the foregoing an amazing revelation, an order and a threat. The revelation that major crime is so prevalent in this city is bad enough. The confession that while citizens are shot down and robbed, most of the criminals escape—all of them in the week to which the chief has reference-is amazing and appalling.

Crime is increasing in large cities generally, due to the depression and other causes, but that is not offeredand the chief does not attempt to offer it-as a valid excuse for the one hundred per cent week's failure in arrest of the criminals. OCT A The chief is to be commended for his

honesty in informing the public of the situation. He acts wisely in prodding situation. He acts wisely in prodding the detectives and policemen, but it may be doubted that a general threat of demotions will get adequate results. The inefficiency of the system and of its requipment may be blamed more than the personnel of the department for its failures. For example, it was reported that the failure of police scouts to capture robbers in one case was due to the fact that maximum speed of the police car was thirty-eight miles an hour. Every passenger car now marketed will travel very much faster. Almost any old flivver parked at the curb and stolen at random will go so much faster that escaping criminals might turn and thumb their noses at police pursuers. If the 38-mile-an-hour scout cars cannot be reconditioned for speed at least equal to that of the average motor car, they should be junked or swapped for a horse

and huggy.

And if the condition of the scout cars is an indication of other weaknesses in the police department, a general investigation may reveal others equally serious. It is quite possible that many brave and capable officers would render more efficient service under improved conditions.
