He retired from the police force after 19 years of service because he wanted to draw pension while serving in the Army. He enlisted in the Army as a 2nd Lieutenant and he received his promotions step by step until he reached the rank of Major (asstired) in the Military Police. He served as an Acting Governor of Ludwigsburg Germany. He received the Papal Honor and the Vatican Medallion for his services to a Medical Mission Aiding Victims of German Concentration camps. After his discharge from the Army he was Compliance Chief for the Toledo Area of Federal Rent Control Agency, after that job petered out he had been transfered to the Provost Marshals office in the Rossford Ordnance Depot.

Services were held Tuesday Nov 19 1957 in Parks-Emmert Funeral home Monroe-and-Otis strsand at 2pm in St. Matthews Episcopalian Church. Burial in Toledo Memorial Park Cemetery. Pallbearers were Members of 148th Ambulance Corps. Funeral was approved by Chief Bosch and Edward De Angelo.
