INJURED ON DUTY, DIES

Patrolman Smith Was Hurt
in Making Arrest.

Houts Family Holds Re-
union—Bowlers Form
a League.

Harry C. Smith, 27, a patrolman, died Monday at 9:40 p. m. at the home of his father, J. W. Smith, of 130 East Broadway, as a result of injuries received while arresting two negroes six weeks ago. At the time he made the arrest he felt that he was injured internally and hemorrhages developed.

Mr. Smith had been on the force but one year, but had already become recognized as an efficient officer. He is survived by his parents, one brother, Norman Smith; one sister, Mrs. O. E. Wolf, of Springfield, and a half-sister, Miss Kate Austin.

The body will be taken to the old home at Pomeroy, Wednesday for interment. Mr. Smith had resided in Toledo for seven years.

Funeral services for Harry W. Smith, patrolman, who died Sunday, were held Wednesday morning at the home of his parents, 130 East Broadway. The body was taken to Pomeroy, O., for burial. Patrolmen Louy and Hass, police pension trustees, accompanied the body.

Smith was a member of the police force about one year. He received injuries while making an arrest which were indirectly responsible for his death, according to physicians.

Patrolman Harry Smith succumbed to injuries sustained approximately six weeks earlier while attempting to arrest two men.

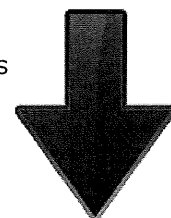
Patrolman Smith had served with the agency for 1 year. He was survived by his parent, brother, and two sister.

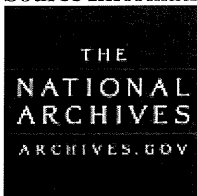
