Right after his retirement he was appointed as a United States Investigator for the O*P*A. The Toledo Price Stabilization Agency, under the direction of Michael V DeSalle, He was relieved of his duty March 1 1953.

Just after 13 days of his promotion to Det-Sergeant in 1920 he and his partner Bernard Cummings arrested 4 gun-men while in the act of robbery of the Liberty Lunch room at Adams -13th strs the capture was made without a shot fired.

He was seriously wounded in 1933 during a pistol battle with the Cleveland Ohio bandits in the hold up of a saloon in the 1900 North 14 th str where an innocent woman was shot and killed as the gun-men grabbed her as a shield, the victim Edna Kingsley a negro in trying to escape, the bandit was shot and killed by his partner Det Lt Frank DeLora and the other 3 bandits all were negroes were arrested and convicted and sent to Ohio Penitentiary for life on a murder in first degree charge, Jury Recommended Mercy.

He was a member of Our Lady of Perpetual Help Church and the Holy name society. And Knights of Columbus. And Toledo Elks. And Toledo Eagles Club. He was a World War 1 Veteran.

Burial services were held from Coyles Mortuary to Church and to Calvary Cemetery.
