

GYMNASIUM FOR POLICE TO BE STARTED MONDAY.

Work on the gymnasium at central police station will begin Monday. Police hope to have it completed in about three weeks.

The gym is to be fitted up on the fourth floor of the building, with the \$2,000 realized from the department's football game last fall. Work was postponed for a time, pending action relative to a new station, and was further delayed by the rush of work for other departments.

Members of the police department will have at their headquarters, when the work is completed, an indoor ball court, a billiard table, a lounging room, and shower baths. The equipment may be removed to a new building in case the old station is abandoned.

A hardwood floor will be put down, and the entire fourth floor will be renovated and repainted. What measures have been taken for ventilating the gym have not been announced. If this end can be successfully attained, it may point the way for improvement in the lower floors of the building.
