

Re: Leonard C. MOCERI - TPD # 23872

Leonard C. Moceri was returned to Toledo, Ohio on January 20, 1953 from Los Angeles, California on a capias. He was arraigned in Lucas County Common Pleas court and entered plea of Not Guilty to indictment # 21529 on February 17, 1953 charging First Degree Murder. On April 22, 1953 this indictment was nolled.

However, on March 24,1953 a secret indictment # 32159 was found against Moceri for Blackmail. On March 26,1953 he entered a plea of Guilty to this and was sentenced from Lucas County (Toledo) Ohio to the Ohio Penitentiary for a period of from one to five years and to pay costs. The date of his release from that institution is not indicated. Rumors indicate that the subject may have recently been living in Detroit, Michigan.

He was arraigned in Lucas County Common Pleas Court and entered a plea of Not Guilty to indictment #21529 on Feb. 17, 1953, charging First Degree Murder. On April 22, 1953 this indictment was nolled.

However, on March 24, 1953, a secret indictment #32159 was found against MOCERI for Blackmail. On March 26, 1953 he entered a plea of guilty to this indictment and was sentenced from Lucas County, Toledo, Ohio, to the Ohio Penitentiary for a period of from one to five years and to pay costs. The date of his release from that Institution is not indicated. Rumors indicate that subject may have recently been living in Detroit, Michigan.



On Jan. 10, 1960 this Department received a long distance telephone call purportedly from the above subject, stating that his conscience was bothering him and he wanted to clear up some past police matters.

He then related that a YGUNIE LICAVOLI did not kill one Jack Kennedy in Foint Place, Unio, now a part of Toledo, but that one JOH ROSCOR was the marderer. He further related that he believed ROSCOE also killed Louise Bell, in Toledo, a year before the Reunedy willing. Oraybach claims to have been an eye-witness to the Kennedy murder and stated that he will give a signed statement concerning what he knows about these marders. He further claims that he had been a bartender at Jack Eannedy's bootlegging establishment, The Slack Hawk Cafe, at the time of these surders. Subject also claims to be a prother-in-law to former Bunicipal Judge Bobert Baumgartner, who is currently vacationing somewhere in California.

We would appreciate your Department interviewing this subject and determining if he is of apparent sound mind, and if so, to have him give a signed statement as to all the particulars and facts he possesses which shows that ROBCOH or any other person than "Map" MUGLISH whose correct name is Sarafino Sinatre, was the assausin of Kennedy.

For your information, both murders of which GRABACH speaks were attributed to the YONNIE LACAVOLI gong which was in operation in Toledo at that time. Kennedy reportedly was a compating bootlegger was refused to pay tribute.

The following facts encorning the above mentioned marders appear in the files of the Tolado Police Department:

Louise BELLAS, kes. 

Marranta were obtained for EBREST JOSEPH DASAGLE, JOHN GRONGE RAI and PETE COFFADO, all members of the Lieuvoli Cang. These were later withdrawn, and on June 6, 1933 a warrent was obtained for LHO MOCHRI, another member of the mob. He was arrested in 1952 in Los Angeles, California, returned to Tolado and allowed to plead guilty to Blackmeil as by then no evidence was any longer available, to prove his guilt in this marder. LEO HOUSELL, also known as INCHARD MOUREL was a Prother-in-law of Younie Licavoli.

Juck Kennedy was later shot and killed on the night of July 7, 1933 at 9:15 to 9:30 HM while walking with a girl friend, Andrey Rolls, on Edgewater Drive near thoth St., while his body guard, Kennoth Francis was visiting a house a short distance away.

WOF EMPLISH whose right name is Seratine SIMATEA, was identified by two eyewitnesses as being the man who pushed Hiss Folis aside and emptied a gun into Kennedy. He was convicted of 1st degree Murder, sentenced to die in the electric chair but had his sentence commuted to LBE by a former Jovernor just before this Jovernor left Office.

JACOB "Firstop" SULKIN, another member of the Licavoli Hob was also charged with the murder of Eannedy and given LIFE in prison. It was proved that he had borrowed the marder weapon from one Samuel Stein, a clerk in a paken shop in the 800 block of Hourse St. that was operated by Louis Igdaloff.

YOUNIE LICAVOLI was also sentenced to LIFE in prison on this marder as being the "master mind" who plotted the killing.

There were several other men with the killer the night ENNIEDY was murdered:

JOSEPH ROSCOE alias Vedo was never known to be a sember of the Licavoli Cang. His file feflects an association with the old ALVIS KARPIS and HAVRY CAMPRELL Sanga. He served time as an accessory after the fact in connection with a bank robbery.



Our records indicate that MOCERI was both a friend and associate of PETER LICAVOLI who is a Brother to Yonnie Licavoli. Yonnie was married to the Sister of MOCERI and is thus his Brother-in-Law. PETER LICAVOLI was reportedly head of the "Purple Gang" who operated in Detroit in that early period.

LEONARD C. MOCERA was returned to Toledo, Ohio on a Capias, on January 20, 1953 from Los Angeles, California. He was arraigned in Lucas County Common Pleas Court, entered a plea of Not Guilty to Indictment #21529 on Feb. 7, 1953, charging him with First Degree Murder. On April 22, 1953 this Indictment was NOLLIED. However, on March 24, 1953 a Secret Indictment #32159 was found against MOCERI for Blackmail. On March 26, 1953 he entered a plea of guilty to this Indictment and was consequently sentenced to the Ohio Penitentiary for a period of one to five years and to pay the costs, from Lucas County Common Pleas Court, Toledo, Ohio.

LEO MOCERI is well known to the Detroit, Michigan Police and has an extensive criminal history in their files. Detroit #28556.

The Los Angeles, California Police Dept. has also an extensive file on him. Their #192790.

Lee Moceri, Russell Syracuse, and Sarafine Sinatra, alias Wop English.

Wop English was convicted by a jury with a verdict of no recommendation; and the article further disclosed that Wop English would probably be electrosuted. The account continues that English collapsed in the court room and was removed to the Judge's private chambers and made the statement that he was innocent of the murder of Kennedy; that he know who killed him but would not dare to talk as they would rip out his tongue. Later an article in the same paper appeared, on Monday, November 20th, that Yop English had requested a conference with the request. The article, by inference, shows that Wop English would probably talk.

If it is possible, could you enlighten me as whether Wop English, in his conference with the Prosecutor, made any reference to any Detroit crimes that he may know of or the Licavoli cutfit was responsible for,

If it is possible. I would like to have a couple of our men interview English for the purpose of finding out as to whether English can throw any light on several partially and some unsolved gang marders that happened in Detroit in the past several years.

The above, Leo Moceri, was indicated for blackmail, to which he shtered a plea of guilty. In my statement to the court at said time, I advised the court that I had agreed to request the return of this indicates and the nolls of an indicatent pending, charging murder, on a plea of guilty to the blackmail charge, on condition that I would recommend to the parole board that Moceri serve the full time of five years under this blackmail charge.

In 1934 Moderi together with Yomie Licavoli and others was indicted for first degree surder. Moderi was not apprehended until Movember 1952 at which time he was arrested in Los Angeles, California and returned to Toledo. Because of the time that had elapsed and the other difficulties attending the trial on an offense which occurred 20 years ago, after conferring with my predocessor in office and the court, I decided to follow the procedure above outlined.

Subject was born May 20, 1907, east portion of Detroit, Michigan. Parents of subject were, Father, Sebastino Moceri; and Mother, Gragyia Parisi Moceri. True name of subject: Calaggiro Moceri.

From the year 1924 to 1930 subject was implicated in robberies and murders in and about the City of Detroit, being questioned and released by authorities who were unable to prosecute subject for any of the alledged crimes.

Known associates of subject during this period was one, James Zarilli of Detroit, Mich. Subject Moceri was a known underworld hoodlum in the business of hijacking, prohibited liquors and illegal gaming establishments.

The years 1930 and 1931, during the split of the underworld leaders, at which time subject was an associate and possible employee of Joe Massi, Florida gambling leader. Subject migrated to Toledo, Ohio, separating from the associates of the then 'dethroned' top syndicate known as the 'Purple Gang'.

As an aftermath of subject's relations with the 'Purple Gang' in and about Detroit, warrants charging implications by subject in the machine gun slayings of the following named persons were issued in Detroit, Mich., naming subject Moceri Oct. 30, 1947. Names of murder victims were:

> Jerry Buckley (a known Radio Commentator) John Dirjundy Milford Jones

and the attempt murder and machine gunning of Police Insp. Garvin. Detroit Police Dept.

During the 'Reign' of the Licavoli gang, (Yonne Licavoli) subject Moceri was known as the top killer and gunman for the organization and while this gang was in the process of 'taking over' all rackets the following persons were shot and killed:

> Abe Luditsky, Oct. 6, 1931 Norman Blatt, Oct. 7, 1931 Louise Bell, Nov. 30, 1932 Jack Kennedy, July 7, 1933

Subject was born May 20, 1907, east portion of Detroit, Michigan. Parents of subject were, Father, Sebastine Meceri; and Mother, Gragyia Parisi Moceri. True name of subject: Calaggire Meceri.

From the year 1924 to 1930 subject was implicated in robberies and murders in and about the City of Detroit, being questioned and released by authorities who were unable to prosecute subject for any of the alledged crimes.

Known associates of subject during this period was one, James Zarilli of Detroit, Mich. Subject Moceri was a known underworld hoodlum in the business of hijacking, prehibited liquors and illegal gaming establishments.

The years 1930 and 1931, during the split of the underworld leaders, at which time subject was an associate and possible employee of Joe Massi, Florida gambling leader. Subject migrated to Toledo, Ohio, separating from the associates of the then 'dethroned' top syndicate known as the 'Purple Gang'.

As an aftermath of subject's relations with the 'Purple Gang' in and about Detroit, warrants charging implications by subject in the machine gun slayings of the following named persons were issued in Detroit, Mich., naming subject Meceri Oct. 30, 1947. Names of murder victims were:

> Jerry Buckley (a known Radie Commentator) John Dirjundy Milford Jones

and the attempt murder and machine gunning of Police Insp. Garvin. Detroit Police Dept.

During the 'Reign' of the Licavoli gang, (Yonne Licavoli) subject Moceri was known as the top killer and gunman for the organisation and while this gang was in the process of 'taking ever' all rackets the following persons were shot and killed:

> Abe Luditsky, Oct. 6, 1931 Norman Blatt, Oct. 7, 1931 Louise Bell, Nov. 30, 1932 Jack Kennedy, July 7, 1933

Secret indictments charging murder of above named persons were issued March 8, 1934, Toledo, Ohio, naming members of the Licaveli gang, subject Moceri included.

"THE LICAVOLI GANG"

The Gang, under the leadership of THOMAS LICAVOLI Number 23444, assumed control of all forms of vice in this city, such as Liquor, Sporting Houses, Slot Machines, etc., and levied a tribute on the operators of same. They also branched out into the legitimate enterprises of the City, and under the guise of "PROTECTION" attempted to levy tribute on Dry Cleaning Establishments and certain other legitimate business places. They ruthlessly killed or destroyed any competitors, and threatened with bodily harm honest business men who would not comply with their nefarious demands.

The Gang assumed such tremendous power and became so bold in their unlawful operations, that the Public and Press finally became aroused, and through the activity of the Prosecuting Attorney, assisted by certain members of the Police Department, the Gang was completely broken up, dispersed and many sent to Prison.

Many killings were credited to the "LICAVOLI MOB"; -however, in many cases evidence could not be had to convict the
mobsters. The following subjects are some of the persons killed; definitely charged to Licavoli and his gangsters:

Evidence was conclusive in the killing of Jack Kennedy, which started the ball rolling and ended in the final dispersement and imprisonment of the Gang.
