ACCEPTANCE OF APPLICATIONS: Applications for the above examination will be accepted beginning Monday, January 16, 1967 and ending when the needs of the service are met. Credentials will be asked for at the oral interview. Applications accepted 8:30 A.M. to 4:00 Monday thru Friday AND 8:00 to 12:00 Noon Saturdays.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

AGE: Applicants must be 21 but not have reached their 31st birthday. Applicants will be removed from the eligible list when they reach their 31st birthday.

EDUCATION: High School Graduate --- G.E.D. certificate acceptable.

RESIDENCY & CITIZENSHIP: Must be a resident of the city of Toledo. This requirement may be waived pending availability of qualified applicants. Must be a Citizen of the United States.

DRIVER'S LICENSE: Must possess valid State of Ohio Operator's License.

PHYSICAL: Height: Min. 5'9" ----- Max. 6'3"  
Weight: Must be in correct proportion to your height.  
If you cannot meet the above height limitations, please do not apply.

WRITTEN EXAMINATION: The written examination will be a general knowledge and abilities and a final score of 70 is required. Applicants must successfully pass the written examination AND a character investigation before they are placed on the eligible list. At the time of pending appointment, eligibles must pass a rigid physical examination.

GENERAL CHECK LIST OF MEDICAL STANDARDS

PATROLMAN

GENERAL APPEARANCE:

The applicant must be free from any marked deformity, from all parasitic or systemic skin diseases, and from evidence of intemperance in the use of stimulants or drugs. The body must be well proportioned and of good muscular development; it must show careful attention to personal cleanliness. Obesity, muscular weakness, or poor physique must reject. Girth of abdomen must not measure more than the chest at rest.

HEIGHT AND WEIGHT:

Patrolmen must be at least 5'9" but not over 6'3" in height. No applicant can be accepted unless he weighs at least 155 lbs.

NOSE, MOUTH AND TEETH:

There must be no obstruction to free breathing, or severe sinus disease. The mouth must be free from deformities or conditions that interfere with distinct speech or a serious disease of the ear, nose, or throat. There shall be no disease or hypertrophy of tonsil or thyroid enlargement. Teeth must be clean, well cared for, and free from multiple cavities. There must be at least two molar teeth to each jaw on each side and these teeth in good apposition for proper mastication. The jaws must be free from badly broken or decayed teeth that cannot be filled or crowned. Missing teeth may be supplied by crown or bridge work; where site of teeth makes this impossible, partial artificial dentures will be accepted. Pyorrhea will reject.

HERNIA:

Actual or potential hernia in any form must reject.

GENITALS:

Must be free from deformities and from marked varicocele, hydrocele enlargement of the testicle, stricture, or urinary incontinence. Retained testicle or total absence of atrophy reject. Any acute and all venereal diseases of these organs must reject.

RECTUM AND ANUS:

Fissures, fistulas, and external or internal piles must reject.

VARICOSE VEINS:

A marked tendency to their formation must reject.

GENERAL CHECK LIST OF MEDICAL STANDARDS (Continued)

EYES:

The applicant must be free from color blindness and able to read with each eye, separately, standard test types at a distance of twenty feet. Loss of either eye, chronic inflammation of the lids, or permanent abnormalities of either eye must reject. 20/20 or 20/30 in one eye, at least 20/40 vision in each eye without glasses.

ARMS, LEGS, HANDS AND FEET:

Must be free from affections of the joints, sprains, stiffness, or other conditions, such as flat feet, ingrowing nails or hammer-toes, which would prevent the proper and easy performance of duty. First (index), second (middle), and third (ring) fingers and thumb must be present in their entirety. Great toe must be present in its entirety.

EARS:

Normal hearing with each ear is required. Whispering voice, 10 feet; low voice, 20 feet and loud voice, 80 feet.

RESPIRATION:

Must be full, easy, and regular, the respiratory murmur must be clear and distinct over both lungs, and no disease of the respiratory organ may be present.

CIRCULATION:

The action of the heart must be uniform, free, and steady, its rhythm regular, and the heart free from organic changes. Blood pressure; systolic maximum 150; diastolic, 90'

NERVOUS SYSTEM:

Brain and nervous system must be free from defects. Epilepsy rejects.

KIDNEYS:

Must be healthy and the urine normal.

WASSERMAN TEST:

Will be made before permanent appointment.

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
