Died July 25 1956 at 2:35pm in Mercy Hospital derved 34 yr

He collapsed while enroute home in his auto at Monroe-Lawrence. he sounded his auto horn to attract the attention of a Radar Crew Patlm James Navarre and Cornelius Petersen, and they called for an Ambulance and rushed him to Mercy Hospital where he died a short time later, Det-Inspector Edward Nasser had sent him home when he complained to him that he was ill, He was on desk duty as all Det-Captains are,

As a U.S. Marine in 1907 he made a trip around the World in the Great White Fleet sent by President Theodore Roosevelt to Demonstrate the United States Sea Power. He also was stationed in the Panama Canal Zone while the Canal was being buildt.

Services were held in Foth's Mortuary 2310 Jefferson Ave. Sarurday July 26 1956 at 1pm. Burial in White House Ohio Cemetery. Pallbearers were- Norton Cassady- John Connors- William Rogers- Harold Fauble- Paul Scheets and Clair Powers.
